

ABOUT THE BOOK

This book of poetic anthology comprises of all my poems which range from free verse, sonnet style, haiku, verse fable and lyrical poetry. Poetry uses forms and conventions to suggest differential interpretation to words, or to evoke emotive responses. Devices such as assonance, alliteration, onomatopoeía and rhythm are sometimes used to achieve musical or incantatory effects. The use of ambiguity, symbolism, irony and other stylistic elements of poetic diction often leaves a poem open to multiple interpretations. Similarly figures of speech such as metaphor, simile and metonymy create a resonance between otherwise disparate images, a layering of meanings, forming connections previously not perceived. Kindred forms of resonance exist, between individual verses, in their patterns of rhyme or rhythm. I have used regular meter, rhyme and rhythm using simple language and soothing verbal melody.

Since I belong to a region of hot climate, some of my poems are reflections of my interpretation of the environment of the region and related flora and fauna. I am also concerned with the moral decay in society and some of my poems touch upon this delicate issue with lyrical bent. Terrorism and peace of the land is another issue I tried to express my anguish in some of my poems with serious concerns. Some poems are chants of my town, Nagpur and its peculiarity which I serve as a tribute to my loving city. In today's increasingly globalized and troubled world, some of the poems provide a serene respite and solace from the 'fever and fret' of life as they are with illustrative pictures to offer a visual treat to the readers' eyes. It is my humble effort in this direction to provide a good and rich experience to the poetry lovers and language learners.
