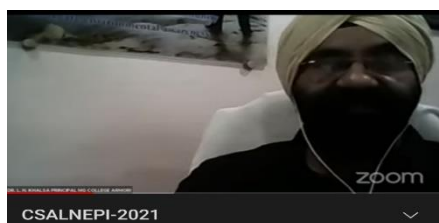

A One Day International E-Seminar titled ‘Changing Scenario of Academic Libraries and National Education Policy of India 2020’ was jointly organized by Mahatma Gandhi Arts, Science and Late N.P. Commerce College, Armori District, Gadchiroli (Maharashtra); Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University, Ramtek; Renuka College, Besa, Nagpur; Government First Grade College, Saligrama, Mysore, and Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora, Goa. This International E-Seminar was held on Monday, 9th August 2021 to commemorate the occasion of Padmashree Dr. Ranganathan’s 129th birth anniversary, also celebrated as National Librarian’s Day.



At the beginning of the Seminar, Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa, Principal of Mahatma Gandhi Arts, Science, and Late N.P. Commerce College welcomed all the dignitaries, conveners, event organizers, and participants. He called libraries the lifeline of knowledge for school

and college students and also research professionals, but he also insisted on the need for traditional physical libraries to evolve. He briefly touched upon the changing scenario of education in the country and the world. Various online platforms like Khan Academy, NDLI, SWAYAM, etc. are emerging as alternative modes of dispensing knowledge. So libraries and library professionals have to change and adapt to this changing reality as progress and change go hand in hand. Sessions like this help in bridging the technological gap in education, he said.





Honorable Dr. Deepak Kumar Shrivastava, Mentor, INELI India and South Asia Divisional Librarian & Head of Govt. Divisional Public Library, Kota, Rajasthan, delivered the concept note. He focused on issues like lack of digitalization of libraries, lack of proper understanding

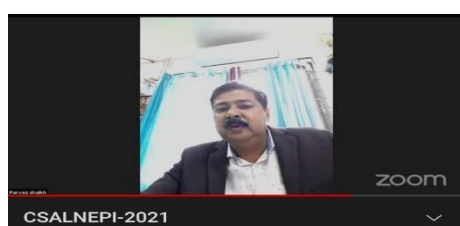

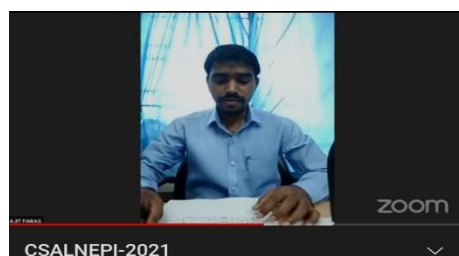
Mandal, Armori.

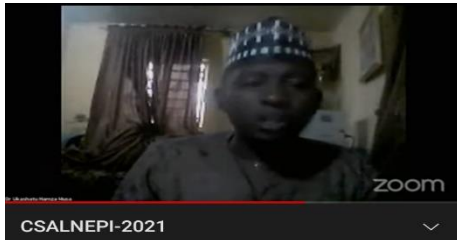

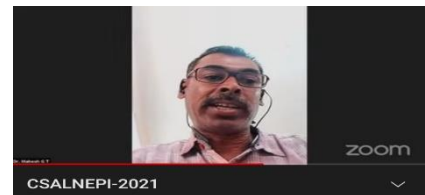
In his presentation, Dr. Kumbhar outlined the unique links between the National Education Policy 2020 and the Educational Libraries.

The second session was chaired by Dr. Jyoti Patil, Principal of Renuka College in Nagpur. In this session, the

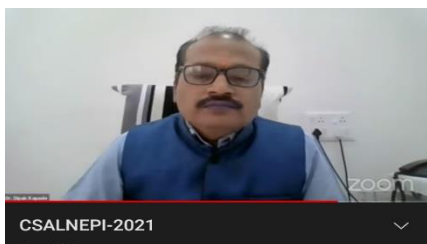


Resource Person Dr. Ukhashatu Hamza Musa gave detailed information on 'Changing Scenario of Academic Libraries', software related to library services, digital

library services, e-facilities, etc. Dr. Mahesh G.T. introduced the Session Chairperson and Resource Person.



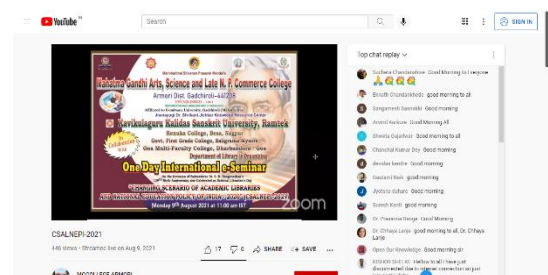
In the third session, under the chairmanship of Dr. Manjunatha E. (the Principal of Government First Grade



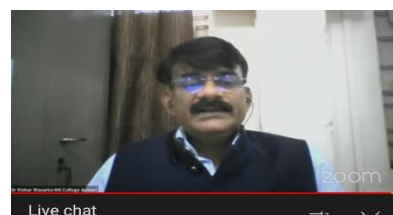
College in Mysore), the participating research students presented research papers based on topics related to the e-seminar theme. Dr. Deepak Kapde Introduced the Chairperson for this session.

Research paper must be typed in the following format only.

- File : MS-Word-2007
- Font (English) : Times New Roman
- Font Size (English) : Title = 16, Sub-Title = 14, Text = 12
- Font (Marathi/Hindi) : Knutidav-10
- Font Size (Marathi/Hindi) : Title = 20, Subtitle = 16, Text = 14

Research Paper must contain the following elements:

- Title of the Research Paper
- Details of the Author (Name, Designation, College Name, Mob. No., Email etc.)
- Abstract not more than 200 words & five Key-words
- Introduction, Body of Research Paper, Conclusion, References
- Author should adopt APA standard references policy for citation for Reference visit: <https://guides.lib.umich.edu/c.php?g=2269&h=26544>
- Word limit for entire research paper is 1500-2000 words.
- While sending research paper, an author and co-author should write his/her Name, Mobile No., e-mail and full address and attach the word file of Paper along with Processing Fee Receipt of Rs. 1500/- per paper. The soft copy is to be sent on this mail: nepeseminar.2020@gmail.com.
- Last Date for Paper Submission: 25th August 2021
- Research papers with less than 15% plagiarism will be accepted. Research Papers having more than 15% plagiarism will be sent back to the authors for necessary modification and correction. Softcopy of Journal will be provided. The decision of the organizing committee shall be final.

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
